With a point of departure in the ERC-funded research project MIGRADEMO, this transversal training session deals with ethical dilemmas, challenges and solutions encountered when collecting, storing and analyzing data. The panel of experts in ethical research standards will share their experience and reflections on both general developments in ethical review procedures as well as concrete issues including, but not limited to, data protection when dealing with sensitive information and vulnerable groups, research permits for data-collection within and outside of the EU, as well as research in non-democratic contexts.

This will be followed by a Q&A where PhD candidates can share doubts, experiences and reflections.
